Subject: Road Closures during Tournament

In case you haven't heard, there will be a marathon run on Wyoming St near the bridge club on Sunday, Feb 18 during our tournament. There will be street closures from 6:30 am until 1 pm. After contacting several City offices, I was referred to the marathon organizer, Mike Coulter, and this is the information he gave me.

There will be "rolling closures" of N-S streets that intersect Wyoming and Arizona and a closure at Montana/San Marcial. This means the police will only let traffic through between groups of runners. Mike is unable to say how long the closures might last. He estimates the closures at Piedras/Wyoming will begin around 7:50 am and those at Mesa/Arizona around 8:30 am.

This will affect anyone coming to the club from I-10, from Mesa, and from the east on Montana.

Here is what Mike recommends:

Coming from I-10: Be prepared for a rolling closure

Coming from Mesa: Take Schuster to Cotton to Montana and turn around at Magnolia or Rosewood onto Yandell

Coming from east on Montana (Carlsbad folks): Take Montana to Reynolds to Yandell. Be prepared for a rolling closure at Yandell and San Marcial

It sounds like everyone should leave earlier than usual.
