

## BRIDGE WITH MR. GERSHOWITZ by Chuck Duke

When I first began playing bridge with Mr. Jerald Gershowitz, He gave me a write-up of his system, and that GAVE ME FITS. He said, don't worry, we can discuss the meaning of each bid. And, over the next few weeks, that is exactly what we did. One by one, we discussed what each opening bid meant. How'd this go? The example that follows might give some hint. Jerald asked me, if you open two diamonds, is it weak or no? He said, just let me know now what you'd LIKE it to show. I replied, I like Roman, you know, a three-suiter, a treatment taught to ME by an experienced tutor. A hand with four-four-four-one, or four-four-five-O, Can be described to a tee by those in the know. JERALD said, I know YOUR Roman, but that's not for us, I reject it for the reasons I now shall discuss. Any system should consider frequency of use. I hope this explanation if not too obtuse. Jerald said, the odds of being dealt four-four-four-one,

Are only 2.99, and that is NOT a ton. And, even if you add hands of 0-five-four-four, The percentage increase is only 1.24. Therefore, as any rank novice can plainly see. The percent likelihood of YOUR Roman is only 4.23. 4.23 percent is only about one board per session. He said, my method is better, let me give you a lesson. The Roman hand shape should be five-four-three-one, OK? The charts I've given to you show this is the best way! Five-four-three-one occurs at a 12.93 percent rate, Over three times as often as YOUR Roman, which I hate. He said, MY version of Roman should make a big hit! You can still show your singleton and still find your fit. I said, but Jerald, is learning all the follow-up bids hard? He said, don't worry, I'll write them on our convention card. Yes, Jerald's bidding theories are sometimes hard to follow, And when you forget them, the results are hard to swallow. What was memorized in December to be JERALD'S way, For an occasional partner, can easily fade away by May. Yes, Jerald has a very analytical mind; myself I repeat. STILL, acquiring one-thousand Master Points is no easy feat. Silver Life Master is a goal many bridge players set. But, the majority of bridge players are not there yet. HOWEVER! JERALD, with all his CHARTS and BOOKS on his shelf, Would be a GRAND Master, if only he could play with himself.
